ENTRY VISA FOR “EMPLOYMENT SUI” (V.N.)

The work visa allows entry, for the purposes of a short- or long-term stay, whether fixed-term or indefinite, to foreign nationals who intend to work in Italy as employees. The requirements and conditions for obtaining the visa are set out in articles 22, 24 and 27 of Legislative Decree n. 286/1998 and articles 29, 30, 31, 38 and 40 of Presidential Decree n. 394/1999, along with the requirements set out in articles 49 and 50 of the same Presidential Decree for the pursuit of professional activities.

The visa application must contain:

1. Duly completed application form (in English or in Italian);
2. Valid passport or travel document (original plus one photocopy), valid at least 3 months beyond the return date of your trip from Italy and at least with two blank pages;
3. Proof of residency in Georgia and possession of a valid Georgian residence permit (original plus a photocopy), which must still be valid for at least three months upon return from the trip;
4. One photograph, compliant with [ICAO](#) standards and taken within the last six months;
5. Nulla Osta (Entry Clearance) issued from “Sportello Unico per l’Immigrazione (SUI)” OR ANPAL (National Agency for Active Labour Policies) OR CONI (Italian National Olympic Committee) in Italy.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The “Nulla Osta” is valid 6 months from the issuing day, therefore you should submit your request accordingly by reserving a slot on the Prenotami online Portal: <https://prenotami.esteri.it/>;

6. Travel ticket reservation. Please note: it must show reservation number, airline company name, passenger’s name, dates of travel and itinerary;
