ENTRY VISA FOR “ENROLLMENT STUDY” (V.N.)

The enrollment study visa allows entry into Italy for the purpose of a long-term, but time-limited, stay for foreign nationals intending to attend a university course at a public or private Italian university.

For all types of ENROLLMENT STUDY visas, **the visa application must contain:**

1. **National Visa (Type D) application form**, duly completed (available in the Form section);
2. **Valid passport or travel document** (original plus a photocopy), with validity of at least three months beyond the planned return date from Italy, and with at least two blank pages;
3. **Proof of residency** in Georgia and possession of a valid Georgian residence permit (original plus a photocopy), which must still be valid for at least three months upon return from the trip;
4. **One photograph**, compliant with [ICAO](#) standards and taken within the last six months;
5. **University pre-enrollment form**, obtained after submitting a request via the University portal at: <https://www.universitaly.it/>. Please note that only students **without pre-enrollment applications “under condition”** may apply for a study visa;
6. **Official foreign academic qualification**, in original plus a photocopy. The final qualification must be accompanied, alternatively, by:
 - A **statement of comparability** and a **statement of authenticity verification** issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC center (CIMEA), or
 - A **Declaration of Value** concerning comparability only, if the Declaration of Value does not explicitly verify the authenticity of the submitted qualification.
 - If the foreign student does not yet possess the local qualification at the time of the visa application, a **provisional certificate** issued by the competent foreign authority may be submitted, according to the rules of the country where the qualification was obtained (in original and translated in Italian language).
7. **Language certification.** For courses taught in Italian or English, students must demonstrate language proficiency with a certificate at least at **B2 level** of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). If language skills have been assessed by the university or

training/internship institution, the consular office reserves the right to verify proficiency through an interview;

8. **One way flight booking;**
9. **Proof of accommodation** if not included in the admission letter: simply applying for or being eligible for housing or university dorm does not constitute valid proof of adequate accommodation;
10. **Adequate health insurance coverage** for medical care and hospital treatment (Art. 39, paragraph 3, Consolidated Law No. 286/1998 and Ministry of the Interior Directive of 01.03.2000), which must also be presented when applying for a residence permit. Acceptable options include:
 - Foreign insurance, provided the assistance coverage is valid in Italy and does not impose limitations or exceptions to the rates for urgent hospital treatment for the full duration of coverage;
 - Insurance policy with national entities or companies, accompanied by a declaration from the insurer specifying the absence of limitations or exceptions to the rates for urgent hospital treatment for the full duration of coverage;
11. **Proof of sufficient financial means** for the intended stay. The required amount is €10,179.85 per year. These funds must come from lawful and traceable sources and may be personal or, alternatively, provided by the family (up to the 4th degree of kinship)

IMPORTANT: The Consular Office will review the documents submitted and reserves the right to request additional information. The Embassy also reserves the right to call students for a brief interview. University pre-enrollment and acceptance by an Italian university do not guarantee automatic issuance of the visa by this embassy. Students are advised to consult the University portal to verify the documents actually required by the universities.

Within 8 days upon arrival to Italy students must apply for the residence permit.

All documentation must be submitted translated in English or Italian language.
